## GREATER SEATTLE USBC YOUTH ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All bowlers must be members of GSUSBCYA or be a USBC Youth member in a Greater Seattle House.

2. AVERAGE CLASSIFICATIONS:

SCRATCH (Optional event for singles only)

**ENTRY FEE: \$13.00 PER EVENT (\$7.75 lineage, \$0.25 expenses, \$5.00 awards)**

3. Bowlers may bowl Team event multiple times from as many leagues as they bowl in regularly, provided that at least two members are changed. The same four members cannot bowl together more than once. All teams will be composed of four members. Mixed teams are allowed.
4. Multiple participation is allowed. The FIRST Singles Event will count toward All-Events. Bowlers may enter the optional Scratch Singles *male and female* division by marking SCR column on entry form. There is no minimum average requirement to compete in Scratch division. Average will be handicapped for All-Events.
5. A bowler may participate in the Doubles Event more than once with different partners. The FIRST Doubles Event will count toward All-Events. Mixed doubles are allowed.
6. Highest average will be taken as of September 1, 2009. Minimum of 12 games for Preps, Juniors, Seniors, and Majors and 8 games for Bantams in a USBC league is required. If required number of games has not been bowled by September 1, coach will certify qualifying average before squad. All others bowl without handicap.
7. All events will be handicapped at 90% of 210, except Scratch Singles.
8. Properly completed forms must be received with correct fees by the postmarked date of October 30, 2009. Phone reservations will be accepted, but completed applications must be received within one week and must be received by tournament closing deadline. No refunds will be made. Checks or Money Orders must accompany applications to be processed.
9. Entrants must bowl in the order in which the names appear on the entry form. In case of substitution, the substitute must take the place vacated by the absent bowler. Once a substitute starts practice, substitute will finish series.
10. Late arrivals shall start bowling the frame then being rolled and will receive a zero score for all frames missed.
11. ENTRANTS MUST CHECK IN ONE-HALF HOUR BEFORE SCHEDULED SQUAD TIME, SHOWING THEIR USBC MEMBERSHIP CARD.
12. Awards shall be on the basis of one for each eight entries in each event except ALL-EVENTS. The All-Events award will be presented to the girl and boy in each class who have the highest 9-game total for scratch and handicapped scores. First series in Singles, Team, and Doubles Events will count toward All-Events total. Achievement ribbons will be awarded per event. Any award money not spent on trophies will be awarded in the form of S.M.A.R.T. scholarships to the top bowlers in each division. All prize money will be returned 100% in the form of trophies or SMART scholarships. SMART account #9426.
13. In case of ties where awards are involved, duplicate awards will be presented.
14. Any appeal or protest regarding tournament scores shall be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours. Computer print outs will be retained for 72 hours after squad ends.

**15 CONDUCT GUIDELINES: These rules will apply to participants:**

- (a) No use of tobacco products or consumption of alcoholic beverages,
- (b) No use of profane language or gestures,
- (c) Bowlers shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner, not interfering with other bowlers or displaying disruptive behavior towards bowling equipment,
- (d) No gambling or pull tab play.
- (e) No sharing of bowling equipment on the same squad. Tournament official will give one verbal warning to violator (s) and adult supervisor. Any further violations could result in immediate disqualification and will be at the discretion of the tournament official.
- (f) Bowlers may not use any bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, illegal substances or inappropriate language/gestures.
- (g) Coaches will be informed of all misconduct complaints and violations by a tournament official.

**16. DRESS CODE** Clothing must be neat, clean and proper fitting. Clothing and equipment used may not advertise or promote any alcohol, gambling, tobacco, illegal substances, or inappropriate language/gestures. Clothing may not be suggestive or offensive. No shorts allowed except for walking shorts or skorts no more than 6 inches above the knees. No excessive tight fitting clothing. No exposed midriff skin when fully extended will be allowed. No hats may be worn during tournament play.

**17** Any bowlers violating USBC Rule on Penalty for Unfair Tactics/Derogatory conduct shall be liable for suspension, behavior problems may result in disqualification.

**18 COACHING:** Participants must remain in settee area and will not be allowed on concourse. Coaching of participants during tournament play will be allowed only if the bowler is at the line when it is his/her turn to bowl. Failure to comply could result in disqualification. In case of an emergency notify a tournament official.

**19.** Coaches will receive confirmation of date and time. It is the coaches' responsibility to notify their bowlers of the date and time of bowling. Coach certifies averages are correct with signature on entry.

**20.** These rules apply to ALL YOUTH bowlers and their COACHES.

**21.** Tournament Director will have final determination in the enforcement of the rules and dress code.

**22. USBC RULES WILL APPLY IN ALL SITUATIONS NOT COVERED BY THESE RULES.**
