# WSBPA Grand Prix Bonanza TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All bowlers must be members of the USBC and join the Grand Prix Scholarship Program.  
(\$7.50 ANNUAL FEE made payable to: Grand Prix Scholarship Program)

2. AVERAGE CLASSIFICATIONS:

3. **ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 PER EVENT: made payable to Grand Prix Scholarship Program**  
**(\$9.50 lineage, \$2.50 expenses, \$8.00 awards)**
4. Bowlers may bowl doubles twice only, each time with a different partner. Mixed doubles are allowed.
5. Bowlers may enter singles only ONCE and may enter the team division only ONCE.
6. Highest average will be taken as of March 1, 2010. Minimum of 15 games for Preps, Juniors, Seniors, and Majors and 10 games for Bantams in a USBC league is required.
7. **Properly completed forms must be received with correct fees by the postmarked date of March 31, 2010. Phone reservations will not be accepted. No refunds will be made. Checks, credit card information or Money Orders must accompany applications to be processed.**
8. Entrants must bowl in the order in which the names appear on the entry form. In case of substitution, the substitute must take the place vacated by the absent bowler. Once a substitute starts practice, substitute will finish series.
9. Late arrivals shall start bowling the frame then being rolled and will receive a zero score for all frames missed.
10. **ENTRANTS MUST CHECK IN ONE-HALF HOUR BEFORE SCHEDULED SQUAD TIME, SHOWING THEIR USBC MEMBERSHIP CARD.**
11. All bowlers will receive a minimum \$25 Grand Prix Scholarship Certificate. Additional larger awards, up to \$1,000 per division, will be made based on entries received per division. **All award scholarships will be returned 100% in the form of Grand Prix Scholarship Certificates.**
12. In case of ties where awards are involved, awards amounts will be divided evenly.
13. Any appeal or protest regarding tournament scores shall be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 24 hours. Computer print outs will be retained for 72 hours after squad ends.

## **WSBPA Grand Prix Bonanza TOURNAMENT RULES, Continued**

### **14. CONDUCT GUIDELINES: These rules will apply to participants:**

- a. No use of tobacco products or consumption of alcoholic beverages,**
- b. No use of profane language or gestures,**
- c. Bowlers shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner, not interfering with other bowlers or displaying disruptive behavior towards bowling equipment,**
- d. No gambling or pull tab play.**
- e. No sharing of bowling equipment on the same squad. Tournament official will give one verbal warning to violator (s) and adult supervisor. Any further violations could result in immediate disqualification and will be at the discretion of the tournament official. Coaches will be informed of all misconduct complaints and violations by a tournament official.**

**15. DRESS CODE: Clothing must be neat, clean and proper fitting. Clothing may not advertise or promote any alcohol, drug, or tobacco product. Clothing may not be suggestive or offensive. No shorts allowed except for walking shorts or shorts no more than 6 inches above the knees. No excessive tight fitting clothing. No exposed midriff skin when fully extended will be allowed. No hats may be worn during tournament play. No iPods or music headsets may be worn during bowling.**

**16. Any bowlers violating USBC Rule on Penalty for Unfair Tactics/Derogatory conduct shall be liable for suspension, behavior problems may result in disqualification.**

**17. COACHING: Participants must remain in settee during tournament play. Coaching of participants during tournament play is encouraged but MUST not be done in the settee areas. Failure to comply could result in disqualification. In case of an emergency notify a tournament official.**

**18. Coaches will receive confirmation of date and squad time assigned. It is the coaches' responsibility to notify their bowlers of the date and time of bowling. Coach certifies averages are correct with signature on entry.**

**19. These rules apply to ALL YOUTH bowlers and their COACHES.**

**20. Tournament Director will have final determination in the enforcement of the rules and dress code.**

**21. USBC RULES WILL APPLY IN ALL SITUATIONS NOT COVERED BY THESE RULES.**
