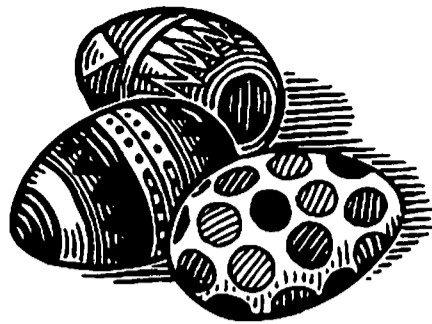

Easter Swiss Trios Tournament Rules

- 1) This tournament is open to all 2009-2010 USBC members in good standing as long as they have did not reach the age of 22 by August 1, 2009. Also, no present or past members of the PBA are allowed. Teams are mix or match trios. Team captains shall check-in for the team, showing all 3 USBC cards. Check-in will be 10:30am. Practice will begin at 11:30pm. This tournament will be USBC certified.
- 2) Bowlers will compete in two divisions: "A" (600-561) and "B" (560 & under). An effort will be made to keep an even number of teams in each division. The total field is limited to 24 teams.
- 3) Entering average: Bowlers will use their highest league average as of March 15, 2010; if none they will use their 2007-2008 high book average. All others will be given a 205.
- 4) Each team shall bowls 8-games of matchplay, with each game a position round based on matchplay points. There are (5) points possible per game (1 pt. per individual win, 2 pts. per team win).
- 5) Entry fee is \$75.00 per bowler, or \$225.00 per team. Entry fee breakdown is: (\$48.00/scholarships, \$27.00/expenses) per bowler. There will be an additional \$15 late entry fee assessed on any entries received after March 31, 2010.
- 6) **Dress code: Bowler must wear a collared shirt. All bowlers must wear slacks, girls may opt to wear skirts, skorts, or dress shorts, but must be an appropriate length. If you have to ask if attire is appropriate it probably isn't. No hats allowed.**
- 7) Good sportsmanship is expected. Poor sportsmanship, including foul language, gestures, and abuse of equipment, will not be tolerated. One warning will be given, with repeat offenses dealt with by disqualification, with no refund of entry fee. Bowlers who intentionally foul will receive zero for the frame.
- 8) Practice starts promptly at 11:30pm. Practice will be 15 minutes. Late bowlers will not be allowed to make-up missed frames, and all missed frames are scored as zero.
- 9) Starting line-up will be according to line-up on the tournament entry form. Team line-ups may not be changed the day of the tournament. Pre-printed recap sheets will be provided each game with the team's original line-ups. Teams may change their line-up at the start of each game, starting with the second game. **Team captains are responsible** to make sure that the correct bowler positions are written next to each name on the pre-printed recap sheets.
- 10) If after 8-games a tie in points exists for any team in a position to win an award, a (1) game roll-off will be used to break the tie. If a tie still exists, Co-winners will be declared.
- 11) If a rule is not covered in the tournament rules, USBC rules will apply. The tournament director(s) have full authority in decision-making, and their decision is final.
- 12) **Reserved entries must be received by March 31, 2010 with a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit to hold the spot.** Entries received after this will be assessed a \$15 late entry fee. Any teams not sure their entry *will reach* us by mail by the deadline should e-mail us their team information, and bring copies of their average verification with them to the tournament. Entries will close on April 3, 2010 at 11:00am, or when a total of 24 entries are received.
- 13) All award/scholarship fees will be returned 100%.
