Rules:

* This tournament is open to all USBC Youth Members in good standing. All bowlers must have a current USBC card. Teams must check in as a team, be dress code compliant and show their USBC cards. Check in starts at 8 a.m., practice at 8:45 and competition will begin at 9 a.m.

* Entering Average: Entrants will use averages in the following order:

- * Highest USBC certified final league average of 21 games or more from the previous winter season.
- * Highest spring/summer league of at least 21 games as of the end of the previous summer season
- * In the event a bowler has a standard average and a sport league average, rule 202d in the USBC Playing Rules book must be observed. It is the bowler's responsibility to use the USBC rule book conversion chart to adjust average. The higher of the two will then be used.
- * USBC Rule 319a(2) – 10-pin rule does not apply.
- * Failure to report a accurate average that results in a divisional change will result in disqualification.

* **There will be an upper average cap of 170 for division A and 140 for division B for any individual bowler in addition to the team average caps.**

* Three games will be bowled on Saturday and three games on Sunday.

* Entering team average will determine the opening match line-up. All following matches will be a position round determined by points won with total pins breaking the ties. In case of a tie at the end of 6 games, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll off to determine the winner. 1 point will be awarded for an individual win, 3 points for a team win for a total of 7 points per game. In the event of an uneven number of teams, the team bowling the BYE will use the scores of the team immediately above them in the standings to determine wins/losses for only the team bowling the BYE. The BYE team or team which scores are being used will NOT earn points.

* Team on left lane (higher seed) will set up line-up then right lane will follow.

* **Dress Code** will be enforced -- Bowlers must wear suitable dress and clothing must be neat and clean. All bowlers must wear dress slacks, dress shorts, skirts or skorts. Shorts and skorts must be below the end of fingertips when arms are hung to side. Shirts may be mock or full collared. Only exception to this would be the national USBC Youth v-neck. **NO JEANS, T-SHIRTS, TANK TOPS, HATS.** No clothing advertising alcohol/tobacco products or gambling. No offensive or suggestive clothing. No mid-drifts or saggy pants. Tournament Director has the final say on any questionable attire.

* Misconduct/Poor Sportsmanship on or off the lanes during the tournament competition will NOT be tolerated. This can result in disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of entry fee, position and any scholarship prize. The rule will be enforced at the discretion of the tournament director and committee

* If there is an error in scoring, contact tournament director or front desk immediately. All other conflicts with the general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after completion of the tournament. The director will decide questionable errors. Any protests must be confirmed in writing to the South Sound USBC Association within 72 hours. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself

* Tournament entry is \$88 per team, which is \$22 per person. Breakdown is \$15.00 for lineage, \$1.00 for expenses, and \$6.00 for trophies. Award ratio is 1:5.
