➤ This tournament is open to all USBC youth bowlers or adult bowlers age 21 and under in good standing. USBC cards must be shown at the tournament office upon check-in.

➤ All bowlers will bowl scratch. Should interest warrant, there will be three divisions for males and females. If less than 8 female bowlers are in a division, they may opt to compete with the male division or have their entry fee fully refunded. A bowler may choose to bowl in a division higher than his/her book average.

➤ Entering Average: Entrants will use averages in the following order:

- Highest USBC certified final league average of 21 games or more from the previous winter season.
- Highest spring/summer league of at least 21 games as of the end of the previous summer season.
- In the event a bowler has a standard average and a sport league average, rule 202d in the USBC Playing Rules book must be observed. It is the bowler's responsibility to use the USBC rule book conversion chart to adjust average. The highest of the two will then be used.
- USBC Rule 319a(2) – 10-pin rule do not apply
- Failure to report accurate average that results in a divisional change will result in disqualification.

➤ **Tournament Fees:** \$50 – lineage \$24.00 / expenses \$1.00 / scholarship \$25.00 (\$5 late fee will be added to scholarship)

➤ Optional Junior Gold Qualifier (Minimum of five males or four females, awarded at 1:5).

➤ **Entries must be received in the South Sound USBC office no later than the 15th of September.**

➤ **Dress Code will be enforced** – Bowlers must wear suitable dress and clothing must be neat and clean. All bowlers must wear dress slacks, dress shorts, skirts or skorts. Shorts and skorts must be below the end of fingertips when arms are hung to side. Shirts may be mock or full collared. Only exception to this would be the national USBC Youth v-neck. **NO JEANS, T-SHIRTS, TANK TOPS, HATS.** No clothing advertising alcohol/tobacco products or gambling. No offensive or suggestive clothing. No mid-drifts or saggy pants. Tournament Director has the final say on any questionable attire.

➤ **Saturday Format:**

Bowl 6 games, moving after each game. Cut field to top 50% or major fraction thereof.

Total pins carry over to Sunday. In the case of a tie at the cut mark, all tied participants will advance to Sunday.

Sunday Format:

Bowl an additional 3 games and cut (if necessary) to appropriate bracket size (IE: 4, 8, or 16).

Match play line-up based on bowler ranking following semifinals (1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc.)

Double elimination finals (1 game matches) where the survivor of the contender's bracket will have to defeat the survivor of the winner's bracket twice in order to win the tournament.

Any ties during the semifinals or matches will result in a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.

➤ All scholarship money will be returned 100%, paid through the SMART Scholarship Program. Acct #9009. Places will be on a 1 to 5 ratio.

➤ All rules not covered will be governed by the USBC. **Refer to USBC rulebook.**

➤ Misconduct/Poor Sportsmanship on or off the lanes during the tournament competition will NOT be tolerated. This can result in disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of entry fee, position and any scholarship prize. The rule will be enforced at the discretion of the tournament director and committee.

➤ If there is an error in scoring, contact tournament director or front desk immediately. All other conflicts with the general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after completion of the tournament. The director will decide questionable errors. Any protests must be confirmed in writing to the South Sound USBC Association within 72 hours. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
