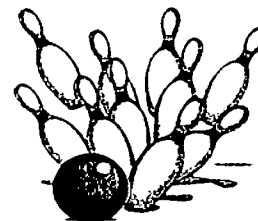

Northwest Youth Bowling Tour Tournament Rules

Entering Average - Please read ALL of the average rule!
Bowlers must bring verification of averages!

Eligibility Rule

Tournament is open to all USBC members that have a current USBC card or purchase USBC membership prior to start of tournament.

Averages used for determining divisions will be as follows:

- a) Current average at time of entry of 21 games or more (composite average accepted to reach a 21 game average) or final winter average from the 2009-10 season for 21 games or more, whichever is highest. Spring league averages will only be used if the bowler does not have a current average (see b). Once a bowler enters with a current average of 21 games or more, that bowler is locked into that division for the year and will not need to submit an average for the remaining tournaments in the 2010-2011 season (subject to rule 319-A of the USBC Playing Rules book).
- b) If no current average, use highest winter 2009-10 ending average for 21 games or more, or 2009-10 ending spring or summer average for 21 games or more, whichever is highest. Bowlers who do not have a current average for 21 games or more are subject to the following rule: Once the bowler reaches a current league average of 21 games or more at time of entry into the next monthly event (composite average accepted), they must show that average and use it if it is higher. If the average puts the bowler in a higher division, they must move to that division. When a bowler moves up a division, placing points do not carry over (attendance points carry over). Once a bowler enters with a current average of 21 games or more, that bowler is locked into that division for the year and will not need to submit an average for the remaining tournaments in the 10-11 season.
- c) If a bowler has no average they will be assigned a 200 average (Tournament director has the right to accept averages under 21 games, but may be subject to re-rate at time of entry. Bowlers must agree to this average prior to the start of the tournament or the entry fee will be refunded and the bowler shall not be eligible to bowl. All bowlers who do not have a current average of 21 games or more must comply to rule b until a current average of 21 games or more is met.)
- d) All bowlers are subject to the following re-rate rule: A bowler that reaches 21 or more games in the NWYBT must use that average for the purpose of handicapping only if it is higher than the entering average. Bowlers that enter the NWYBT tournament with a 2010-2011 season average will not be forced to move to an upper division at any time.

Tournament Format

All bowlers will enter the tournament in their respective scratch division (boys and girls together). Bowlers may move up a division, but must stay in that division for the season. Bowlers will bowl six (6) games of qualifying. After the six games of qualifying, 40% from each division will qualify for the scratch match play rounds in their division (If there is not enough entries in a Division total pins will determine the winner of that division). The remaining bowlers from all divisions will then have their handicap added to their score and the top 30% will advance to the Satellite handicap match play round. The minimum number of qualifiers for a round will be four bowlers. The bowlers will start at zero for the match play round (no pin carry over). In the match play round all bowlers will bowl four (4) games with the first three (3) games using the appropriate schedule provided by the NWYBT. The fourth game will be a position round. Bowlers will receive 30 bonus pins per win, 15 pins each for a tie. One (1) out of two (2) bowlers from the semi-final round in each division will advance to the step-ladder format finals (minimum of three (3) bowlers and maximum of five (5) bowlers). Single elimination, no pin carry over. All semi-finalists will receive awards.

Junior Gold Qualifier

The January 2011 session will also be a JUNIOR GOLD Qualifying event in conjunction with the North West Youth Bowling Tournament.

Dress Code

No Shirts that have any offending pictures or writing. All shirts must have a collar. No mid-drifts showing when fully extended at the lines. Pants must be worn fully pulled up. No skirts, skorts are allowed. No pants that have holes in them. All attire is subject to the approval of the Tournament Director.

Handicap

The handicap shall be 90% of 210. Bowlers averaging over 210 shall receive zero (0) handicap.

Entry Fee

Entry fee shall be \$30.00 per tournament and broke down as follows: \$18.00 Lineage Expense, \$4.00 Awards Expense, \$ 7.00 Tournament Expense, \$ 1.00 Tournament of Champions Awards Expense. Non-members will not be eligible to earn points for the Tournament of Champions or end of season awards. Prize fund will be returned 100%.

Membership Fee

Membership fee shall be \$15.00 for the 2010-2011 bowling season. Membership fees will be used towards the awards for the NWYBT.

Awards

Tournament winners (top three finalists) will receive scholarship funds. Awards in each division will be guaranteed on a 1 to 10 ratio. Championship winners in each division will be awarded scholarships, all funds will be deposited in the SMART program (Acct #9697). Deposits will be made after each Event.
