Spare Time Layne Swiss Rules

1. This tournament is open to all USBC members in good standing. All bowlers must have a USBC card. Bowlers may purchase a USBC card at the tournament.
2. Your composite 2010-2011 book average will be used. Sport averages will be used only if no house average exists.
3. If a bowler does not have a book average, females will use 170 and males will use 190.
4. Entering doubles average will determine the first match for the event. Eight games will be bowled each day, position rounds each game.
5. All bowling will be scratch.
6. One (1) point is to be awarded for each individual point and three (3) points for winning doubles total. That makes a total of five (5) points per game. For ties throughout the first 15 games, total pin fall will break the tie. If there is a tie for first place at the end of the 16 games, a 9th and 10th frame roll off will be bowled. All other ties at the end of 16 games will be determined by total pin fall.
7. If there is an uneven amount of teams, the team bowling the vacant will bowl the scores of the team to their left to determine points won.
8. Team lineup must stay the same for all 16 games. Substitutes will be allowed as long as the average of the sub does not change put the team over the cap.
9. Any changes to the starting lineup must be done before practice begins to allow adequate time for coordinators to verify averages.
10. A side singles tournament will be run if there is enough interest. The scores from the first six games of team will be the scores used for singles. Bowlers can enter each day, but cash only once. Cost is \$20 per person, 100% to a prize fund, payout ratio of 1 in 4.
11. Dress code: No jeans will be allowed. Bowlers must wear a collared shirt or shirt with mock collar. No sleeveless shirts will be allowed.
12. Fees: Cost for team is \$75 per person (\$150 per team), \$32 to lineage, \$43 to prize fund. The prize ratio will be 1 in 4. To reserve a spot, the team fee must accompany the entry.
13. All scholarship money will be administered by the SMART program. Please make checks payable to "Spare Time Boosters."
14. Trophies will be provided by our sponsor, Layne of Washington, Inc.
15. This tournament is USBC certified : 04227. All other rules will be governed by the USBC rule book.
