Format

Qualifying is 6 games bowled across 3 pair of lanes. Lane condition will be a combination (COMBO) of Long Condition and a Short Condition. Long on left lane, Short on the right lane. Cut to 2, 4, or 8 depending on number of bowlers in each division. Finals will be a seeded bracket with best of 3 games elimination matches. High seed chooses starting pattern and each game is bowled entirely on one pattern and then alternating patterns each game.

2011 Spring Combo Shootout

- 1. Eligibility:** This is a singles competition in two divisions (**Boys Open, Girls Open**). All entrants must be a current USBC members in good standing.
- 2. Check-in:** Check-in time will begin at 9:00 AM. All bowlers must be checked in by 9:30 AM, and walk-in entries will close at that time. Practice will be at 9:45 AM. Tournament competition will begin at 10:00 AM. Lane assignments will be announced prior to the start of practice.
- 3. Entry Fee:** The entry fee is \$45.00. The fee breakdown is: (Prize Fund-\$24.00, Expenses-\$21.00)
**NOTE: All walk-in entries that do not have reservations will be charged an additional fee of \$5.00
- 4. Prize Fund:** All scholarship monies will be returned 100%. All scholarship awards will be deposited with the USBC SMART program.
- 5. Conduct:** Poor behavior, to be determined by the Tournament Director, will not be tolerated on or off the lanes and may result in disqualification. Bowlers may not interfere with any other bowlers delivery. "Running" out shots will not be allowed until the finals.
- 6. Tournament Format:** This is a scratch singles competition. The lane conditions will be a long pattern (43ft or >) on the left lane and a short patter (37ft or <) on the right lane. **QUALIFYING** will consist of 6 games. Bowlers will move after every (2) two games with odd numbered lanes moving left and even numbered lanes moving right. Bowlers will follow arrows each game. Upon completion of the qualifying games, there will be an approximate 50% cut to either 2, 4 or 8 bowlers depending on the number of entries with a maximum of 8. Cuts will use a major fraction to determine rounding. **FINALS** will consist of a seeded bracket according to qualifying position (i.e. 1st vs 8th, 2nd vs 7th, etc..). Each round of the finals will be a best of 3 games match. Each game of a finals match will be played on a single lane. The higher seeded player selects the starting lane for the match. Each game of a match will alternate within the pair of lanes. A winner is determined when one player reaches 2 wins. Losers from each round are eliminated. Ties will be broken by a sudden death roll off. In sudden death, each round will consist of each player having (1) deliver. The high seeded player will select the starting lane of the sudden death round. A winner will be determined if (1) one player has a higher pin count after (1) one round than their opponent. If more than (1) one sudden death round is need to determine a match winner, the rounds will alternate lanes within the pair of lanes. Finals rounds will continue until there is a champion.
- 7. JOG Qualifier:** During The Turkey Combo Shootout, a Junior Gold (JG) qualifying event will be held. The JG qualifying is optional and has a separate entry fee and entry form.
- 8. Dress Restrictions:** Competitors **MUST** wear collared shirt, preferably with their name on the back (name not required). Competitors **MUST** wear dress slacks or Dockers style pants. Girls may wear hemmed shorts or skirts of appropriate length. **NO** jeans will be allowed. Tournament management reserves the right to determine what constitutes proper dress for participation. A good rule of thumb is if you have to ask if it is allowed, you probably shouldn't wear it.
- 9. Protests:** Any protests must be brought to the Tournament Director immediately at the time of the infraction.
- 10. Tournament Management:** The decisions of the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rules.
