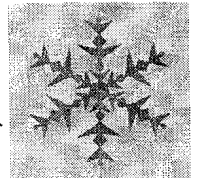

Wally Ball Index Explained

How many of you are up nights wondering what the Wally Ball Index is? Lots I bet... so here is the explanation so you can get some sleep.

This construct, from the mind of a genius, is an index number arrived at by assigning 1 pt for 200's, 2 pts for 1200's, 4 pts for 1300's, and 6 pts for 1400's; then shift the decimal point 1 place left.

The madness behind the method was to arrive at an index number that will allow a person to determine if the lanes were tough or not. High index = easy, low index = tough. The 2008 WBI average is 11.2
