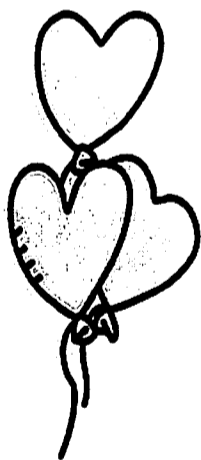

All Star Applications Out Again Today

Greater Seattle USBC Youth All Star applications are out today, and if you bowl PSTL, you qualify to apply. Bowlers are required to be in two leagues in separate centers or travel leagues, and one of them must be GSUSBC sanctioned, which PSTL is. Applications are due on March 15th. Points are calculated based on averages and participation in association tournaments, and the top 16 bowlers are invited to the All Star Tournament, which is also a JG qualifier. The All Star tournament will be held in April and points are added to totals based on the bowlers finish in the tournament. As soon as the points are tallied, the teams are named.

If you are unsure whether to apply, you should do it. At the least it's a great experience, at best you could make the team!
