Tournament Format

Doubles teams shall consist of 1 adult and 1 youth bowler. Tournament is handicapped at 90 of 220. All games will be baker format (bowler 1 rolls frames 1,3,5,7,9 and bowler 2 rolls frames 2,4,6,8,10). There will be a qualifying round of 5 games followed by a finals round where the top 16 qualifiers are seeded on to a bracket and compete in a single elimination baker format matchplay. See rules on back for more details. **Cost is \$32 per team.**

ADULT / YOUTH BAKER DOUBLE TOURNAMENT RULES

1 All doubles teams in the Adult/Youth Baker Doubles Tournament will be made up of 1 Youth and 1 Adult. Bowlers must be USBC members in good standing.

2 This is a handicap tournament. The average used to figure handicap will be an average of the 2 bowler's averages. This will be arrived at by adding the 2 averages together and dividing by 2. All fractions will be dropped. Handicap will be 90% of 220.

3 **Averages:** Adult and youth bowlers must use their highest 2006/2007 book average. If no book average is available then bowlers must use highest current average of at least 21 games. Those with no book or current average will use an average of 200. The tournament director reserves the right to re-rate a bowlers entering average.

4 **Tournament Format:** All games in this tournament will be Baker Format (bowler #1 rolls frames 1,3,5,7,9 and bowler #2 rolls frames 2,4,6,8,10). In all games the adult will be bowler #1 and youth will be bowler #2.

Qualifying: There will be 5 games of qualifying. Upon completion of the qualifying games the field will be cut to the top 16 doubles teams based on total pins plus handicap. If there are 16 teams or less, the cut will be to the top 8 teams.

Matchplay Finals: The finals will be single game elimination matchplay. Finalist will be placed on a bracket according to their qualifying finish with 1st vs. 16th, 2nd vs. 15th, and so on. The winner of a match will be determined by total pins for one game plus handicap. The winners of each game will advance to meet their next opponent according to the bracket. Upon completion of the round of four, the winners will roll-off for 1st and 2nd and the losers will roll-off for 3rd and 4th.

5 **Conduct:** Use of profanity, kicking the ball returns or foul lights, or any undue display of temper will be cause for disqualification.

6 There will be no consumption of alcohol by bowlers during the event.

7 The tournament director shall have complete authority in matters concerning this tournament and their decision shall be final.

8 Any rules not covered here will be governed by USBC.
